## Additional notes.

Petrol consumption was high in December not only because of the drive back from Brasov to Iasi after purchasing the car, but because of bad conditions which reduced speed dramatically and thus increased fuel consumption in rural areas in the time of delivering Christmas aid to families over many days.

It took 4 days for 3 local volunteers working in sub zero conditions to chop and sack up 9 meter cube of wood for distribution to the needy and in January I feel RCHF must purchase a chainsaw as the work could have been done in less than a day with one.
